QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS:

QUESTION: Are there any extensions or is this for one (1) year?

ANSWER: 1 Year only.

QUESTION: How much was expended for this product last year?

ANSWER: \$ 78,667.00.

QUESTION: What was the name of the product used? How was it applied...via injection pumps, manually added. Can you provide an MSDS.

ANSWER: Name: Micro –Solve, applied via injection pumps in 9 lift stations and manually added at the WWTP (Headworks & digesters) MSDS available.

QUESTION: Does this contract require any bonding?

ANSWER: No, bonding is not required for this contract.

QUESTION: Does the current purveyor provide any service with this contract? (monitoring, inventory, sampling for odor/FOG values)

ANSWER: Yes, They provide monitoring along with progress & assessment reports .

QUESTION: Is there historical data on FOG testing (fats, oils, and grease), and are those test results available? Where were those sample points, (lift station(s), headworks, and effluent?)

ANSWER: NO.



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QUESTION: Is the historical data on the odor testing for H2S? Are those tests available? Where were those sample points, (lift station(s), headworks, manholes?)

ANSWER: H2S levels are continually monitored on a monthly basis at all lift stations treated with Micro –Solve.

QUESTION: What is the daily average flow to the wastewater plant, and how many plants are under the department that would apply to this contract? What is the average BOD reading?

ANSWER: Average flow For Sept. 2015 @ 8.152 MGD, one (1) plant, Average BOD @ 6.2 mg/L

QUESTION: Is the trial product for the entire system or just a designated portion?

ANSWER: Designated portion.

QUESTION: Are there any vendor registration procedures that are required to bid on this contract?


ANSWER: No, the City does not require a vendor to register in order to submit a bid. All formal bids are open to all interested vendors.
